Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® Program

Making your home more energy efficient is one of the best investments you can make. Improving the "building envelope" or "shell" of the home can reduce your energy bills, improve the comfort of your home, and protect the environment.

Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR (AHPwES) Program works with low-to-moderate income homeowners and financially rewards them for making eligible air sealing and insulation improvements.

Eligible homeowners receive no cost energy assessments and enhanced financial rewards of 75% off of the improvement cost, up to \$2,500. Plus, you will receive:

- Performance testing performed by a BPI-Certified Trade Ally
- Detailed computer report outlining recommendations and return on investment
- Post-performance testing and verifications
- FREE energy-saving products and installation of compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs), high efficiency showerheads, and water-saving kitchen and bathroom faucet aerators

HOMEOWNER ELIGIBILITY

Assisted Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program eligibility requirements include:

- Owner-occupied, single-family or multifamily residence of 3 or fewer units
- Homeowner must be a customer of a participating Wisconsin utility company
- At least 50% of the home must be heated through natural gas or electricity from a participating utility company
- Homeowner must complete an Income Eligibility Application and be able to verify that their income is within 60-80% of the state median income (see chart on back)
- Eligible improvements must be made by a participating AHPwES Trade Ally
- Installations must be completed twelve months from the homeowner's income eligibility application approval date
