The base cost effective February 1, 2019 is \$0.0550/kWh.	All sales of electrical energy are subject to 5.5% sales tax. However, a law (\$77.54(30)) was enacted in February 1979 providing a Sales and Use Tax Exemption for electricity sold for residential or farm use during the months of November through April.
