1000 Islands Environmental Center is holding a tree seedling sale to offer landowners and homeowners the opportunity to improve and protect the environment while beautifying and increasing the value of their property. Proceeds of the sale are used to fund educational programs conducted by the Nature Center staff. All tree seedlings are bare root. 1000 Islands Environmental Center makes every effort to ensure tree seedling health, but we cannot offer any guarantees.

Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*) A fast-growing, hardy and adaptable to many soil types. Prefers partial to full sun. The soft wispy needles are clustered in groups of five. Excellent ornamental if sheared lightly. Commonly used as a windbreak, reforestation, shade trees and Christmas trees. Can grow 60-80' hight and 20-40' spread. *10* seedlings per bundle.

White Spruce (Picea glauca) The White Spruce is an evergreen with dense foliage, needles that are blue-green in color and is a long-lived conifer. This conifer grows faster than many other spruces. Commonly found in nature along streams and lakeshores, this spruce is more shade tolerant than most others. A great choice for heavier soils such as clay. Very popular as a Christmas tree, the White Spruce is also naturally deer resistant and provides high wildlife value. Can grow 50-70' high and 15-20' spread. *10 seedlings per bundle.*

Swamp White Oak (*Quercus bicolor*) As the name suggests, this oak is found growing wild in low-lying and swampy areas — often moist bottomlands or river banks. But it grows just as well in an urban or suburban setting, with tolerance to compacted soil and (perhaps surprisingly) drought. The swamp white oak is a great choice for a shade or street tree, with the ability to grow at a moderate pace and live more than 300 years. Its leaves are whitish on the underside and green on the top sides and the trees produce acorns that wildlife enjoy. Can grow 60-80' high and 60-80' spread. *10 seedlings per bundle*

White Oak (Quercus alba) Rounded, broad-rounded or upright rounded when mature that makes it an ideal shade tree. This is a classic oak tree. Moderate growth each year with small, elongated acorns. Prefer full to partial sun and should be planted in an area where the tree has room to grow and where the root zone will remain undisturbed. Showy, purple-red long lasting foliage. Can grow 60-80' high and 60-80' spread. 10 seedlings per bundle

Sugar Maple (Acer saccharum) A large shade tree that exhibits dark green leaves that turn burnt orange, yellow and red in fall. Moderate growth rate and likes loamy and sandy soils. Although shade tolerant, full sun needed for proper development. Can grow 50-70' high and 35-45' spread. **10 seedlings per bundle**

Shagbark Hickory (Carya ovata) The shagbark hickory is an excellent shade tree that gives a stunning display of gold leaves in autumn. It is initially a slow growing species that may reach a height of 60-80' with a 30-40' spread. Best known for its distinctive gray-brown shaggy bark which adds an element of winter interest. An upright tree, it becomes more round topped as it matures. This tree produces large, edible nuts that are touted for their sweet flavor and hickory scent. **10 seedlings per bundle**
