We accept cash, debit card, credit card, or check. Checks can be made out to 'Recycle That Stuff'

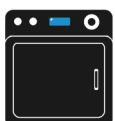
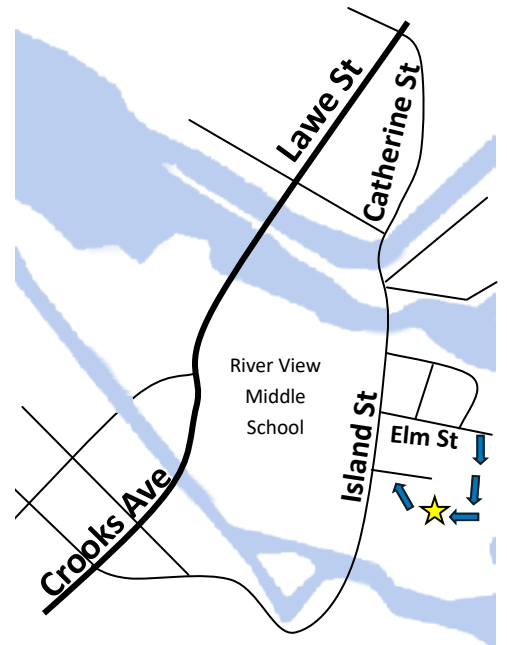
Flat and Tube TVs (29" & under)	\$20 ea	Flat & Tube Computer Monitors	\$20 ea
Flat and Tube TVs (30" - 49")	\$40 ea	Wood Console or Projection TVs	\$60 ea
Flat and Tube TVs (50" & over)	\$60 ea	Large Copy Machines/Printers	\$15 ea
