1000 ISLANDS 2023 TREE AND SHRUB SEEDLING SALE

This year we are offering a tree and shrub seedling sale to give homeowners the opportunity to improve and protect the environment while beautifying and increasing the value of their property. All proceeds from the sale are used to fund environmental education programs and events.

Important Order Information:

- Tree and shrub seedlings are ordered from a quality Wisconsin nursery. Neither the nursery or 1000 Islands can guarantee or warranty the survival rate of any plant due to variables outside our control.
- Orders from the nursery could be cancelled by situations beyond our control. If this occurs, a refund will be given. All orders are subject to availability.
- All seedlings are bare root. Tree seedlings are sold in multiples of 10 and shrubs in multiples of 5 only.

TREE SEEDLINGS (10 seedlings per bundle)

Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*) Fast-growing, hardy and adaptable to many soil types. Prefers partial to full sun. Can grow 60-80' high with a 20-40' spread.

White Spruce (*Picea glauca*) An evergreen with dense foliage; needles are blue-green. This conifer grows faster than many other spruces and is naturally deer resistant. Can grow 50-70' high with a 15-20' spread.

Swamp White Oak (*Quercus bicolor*) This oak is found growing wild in low-lying and swampy areas but is also found in suburban setting, with tolerance to compacted soil and drought. Grows at a moderate pace, producing acorns that wildlife enjoy. Can grow 60-80' high with a 60-80' spread.

White Oak (*Quercus alba*) A classic oak tree and shade tree. Moderate growth each year with small, elongated acorns. Prefers full to partial sun and planted in an area where it has room to grow and where the root zone remains undisturbed. Purple-red long lasting foliage. Can grow 60-80' high with a 60-80' spread.

Red Maple (*Acer rubrum*): The red maple provides you with red color year round. This tree is very adaptable to most soil types and moisture conditions. Brilliant ruby red, orange and yellow leaves with red stems adorn the Red Maple tree as temps cool off and days shorten. Can grow 40-60' high with a 35-45' spread.

SHRUB SEEDLINGS (5 seedlings per bundle)

American Elderberry Shrub (*Sambucus canadensis*) A spreading shrub producing large clusters of small edible berries. Perfect for naturalizing wide open areas like a farm field; providing excellent cover for wildlife. Does well in wetter areas and is used for erosion control along rivers and streams. Can grow 10-15' high with a 10-15' spread.

Gray Dogwood Shrub (*Cornus racemosa*) A small to medium sized shrub. Very adaptable and does well on dry upland or wetland sites, in full sun to full shade. Found along streams and ponds, fence rows, roadsides and forest edges that spread to form a thicket. Excellent for erosion control with its fibrous root system. Can grow 6-10' with a 6-10' spread.

Nannyberry Viburnum Shrub (*Viburnum lentago*) Arching branches of glossy green leaves adorn this multi-stem shrub. Versatile and apt to sucker, Nannyberry is excellent for naturalizing in moist areas, near stream banks, or in low wooded areas. Sturdy shrub for borders, hedge, or screen. Can grow 15-25' high with a 6-12' spread.

Downy Serviceberry Shrub (*Amelanchier arborea*) This attractive shrub is also classified as a small tree. The berries produced are a favorite of bakers. Berry crops will generally be available to harvest within 3 to 5 years of planting and will produce an average of 4 to 6 lbs. of berries each season. Can grow 15-25' high with a 15-25' spread.
