## **BILL PAY ASSISTANCE - AVAILABLE AGENCIES**

1 Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP)

The WHEAP provides assistance for heating costs, electric costs, and energy crisis situations. Operating with federal and state funding, the program provides assistance to approximately 225,000 Wisconsin households annually. Whether you use wood, propane, natural gas, electricity, or fuel oil to heat your home, energy assistance is available if you qualify.

Your household may be eligible for WHEAP services based on a number of different factors, including if your gross household income qualifies for assistance. A Home Energy Plus application must be completed through your local WHEAP agency. It takes as little as 10 minutes to get started - call 1-800-506-5596 or visit energybenefit.wi.gov. Applications are processed October 1 to May 15 each year.

Keep Wisconsin Warm/Cool Fund (KWW/CF)

The KWW/CF is a statewide non-profit charitable effort that was established in 1996 to keep the heat and power on for thousands of Wisconsinites most vulnerable in crisis. KWW/CF provides preventative services and the financial assistance necessary to alleviate potential life-threatening energy-related emergencies during Wisconsin's harsh winters and blistering hot summers. 3 WI Help for Homeowners (WHH)

WHH is a new statewide program that can help with overdue bills like mortgage payments, property taxes, and utilities. The program is open to homeowners in Wisconsin with overdue housing-related bills, both with and without a mortgage, who meet income and other eligibility requirements, and have experienced a qualified economic hardship since January 21, 2020.
