
We're excited to announce a community open house to engage with our valued customers! This event will provide insight into potential enhancements to the water system and shed light on aging water infrastructure.

The Kaukauna Utilities Water Department began residential spring hydrant flushing on Monday, April 8th.


Flushing will be done during daylight hours from 7:30am to 3:00pm and will take approximately three weeks to complete.




### **RECYCLING EVENT**
