In early October, we joined more than 2,000 public power utilities across the country in celebrating Public Power Week - a time to recognize the value of locally owned, not-for-profit utilities like Kaukauna Utilities.

Being a public power utility means we're owned by the communities we serve, *not investors*. That local ownership allows us to focus on what matters most to our customers: keeping rates affordable, service reliable, and decisions made close to home.

YEAR-ROUND SALES TAX EXEMPTION

Effective October 1, 2025, sales tax will no longer be applied to residential electricity charges in accordance with Wisconsin State Law Act 15. Previously, this exemption applied only during the winter months (November through April), but it will now remain in effect year-round.

This change ensures that all residential electricity use is exempt from Wisconsin sales and use tax, helping customers save a little more every month.

First-time eligible applicants receive a \$50 KU gift card, and all eligible applicants will be entered to win one of three \$100 gift cards (must apply at the event).




APPLIANCE REBATES AVAILABLE
